Installation and Operation of a Configuration Management Database (CMDB)

IT inventory is not static. Hardware changes such as upgrades, decommissioning, new acquisitions, maintenance and losses are part of daily business. Unused capacity needs to be reallocated and performance must be optimized. In addition, new software releases and patches are implemented continuously. If you want to execute all these changes under controlled conditions, with minimal risk, you need an exact, accurate picture of your inventory including its allocation and use.

When planning new or enhanced hard- and software implementations, an IT organization has to know precisely which configuration items (CIs) will be affected. The IT team also needs to understand which services are underpinned by which configuration items. Only then can changes be implemented with minimal effect.



Technical infrastructure can be planned optimally, the change management process monitored and inventory controlled fully throughout the complete asset lifecycle.

Compliance requirements can be met easily, as changes to the IT infrastructure are documented and archived and single authorization steps are recorded comprehensibly.

iET CMDB Intelligence Functionalities

iET CMDB Intelligence transfers filter-based asset discovery data into a database. This database containing current data is the "Inventory Staging Area". Current IT infrastructure data is stored separately from the CMDB inventory and the two data types are automatically compared. iET CMDB Intelligence identifies discrepancies between the current data and the CMDB inventory and compares the data directly against each other.

iET CMDB Intelligence integrates besides iET Inventory Center also third party systems such as Microsoft MECM*, InControl* and enteo*.





- ► Time savings in incident management through immediate availability of all required CI details




